

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR HARVEY CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Mayor Christopher J. Clark called the City of Harvey Regular Council meeting to order Monday – April 12, 2021 at 7:05 p.m. by Video conference.

Tim Williams, City Administrator, mentioned that this went before the Planning Commission. He commented that there are repair shops and Auto shops that have not been following the code. He continued to say that Auto dealers have been doing business and not licensed to do so. He pointed out that the City is looking for an opportunity of 6 months in which they can create a committee to help out with this issue.

Alderman Randle-El made the motion to adjourn meeting. The motion was seconded by Alderman Rogers.


