<u>Resolution # 2922</u> - A Resolution to approve an intergovernmental agreement with Cook County regarding the Cares Act Subrecipient Funding. (Sponsored by Mayor Clark)

Mayor Clark: "This Resolution is a letter of intent to Cook County that the City of Harvey intends to receive funding through the Cares Act program to deal with Covid related issues."

Alderman Rogers would like to know how the Grant money is being spent and how future Grant money will be spent. He also wants to know how the Cares Act money will be spent.

Mayor Clark pointed out that this money is not a Grant but a letter of intent to Cook County to let them know that the City of Harvey intends to receive approximately 700,000 dollars that was granted to the City under the Cares Act.

Alderman Randle-El made the motion to approve Resolution for the intergovernmental agreement for the Cares Act funding program. The motion was seconded by Alderman Crudup.
