# ORDINANCE NO. 3242

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES IN THE COOK CO. CLERKS OFFICE CITY OF HARVEY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2009 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2010 DEC. 2 2 2009

WHEREAS the City City

WHEREAS, the City of Harvey (hereinafter "City") is a home rule municipality and an DIVISION such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Harvey, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of the City's home rule powers, as follows:

#### **ARTICLE I**

That the amount of taxes for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2009 and ending April 30, 2010 for all corporate purposes, exclusive of sums or amounts necessary for (1) Park Fund; (2) Library; and 3) Special Service Districts, to be levied upon all property subject to taxation with the City of Harvey, including railroads as the same is assessed and equalized for State and County purposes for said year be and the same is hereby fixed at EIGHT MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY NINE THOUSAND AND EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY ONE DOLLARS (\$8,759,841) AND SAID SUM IS HEREBY ACCORDINGLY levied upon all property in said City subject to taxation aforesaid.

That the said sum of EIGHT MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY NINE THOUSAND AND EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY ONE DOLLARS (\$8,759,841) being taxes to be levied for the fiscal year of this ordinance shall, when received, be used for the purpose of paying the following items for each of which an appropriation has been made in and by an Appropriation Ordinance passed by the Council of the City of Harvey; that the specific items as they appear in the Appropriation Ordinance are itemized hereinafter in the column headed "Appropriation" and the specific items and the amounts herein and hereby are listed in the column headed "From Tax Levy".

## **ARTICLE II**

Additionally, there is hereby levied on all of the property subject to taxation within the City of Harvey, such sum is represented by 5% for bonds and 3% of all other extendable levy items, which sum is hereby authorized to be extended additionally for Loss and Cost.

#### ARTICLE III

The Mayor is empowered and directed to execute and to cause to be filed with the County Clerk of Compliance with the Truth in Taxation Act, the term requirements and conditions of which have been met at and before the adoption of this ordinance.

### **ARTICLE IV**

The City Clerk of the City of Harvey be and is directed to forthwith file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Clerk of Cook County for the purpose of having extended the taxes levied under the terms hereof and to enable the proper authorities to collect the same when extended.

#### **ARTICLE V**

This Ordinance shall be in effect upon passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
