LEVY ORDINANCE #3335

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES IN THE CITY OF HARVEY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2015 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2016

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Harvey, Cook County, Illinois:

ARTICLE 1

That the amount of taxes for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2015 and ending April 30, 2016 for all corporate purposes, to be levied upon all property subject to taxation with the City of Harvey, including railroads as the same is assessed and equalized for State and County purposes for said year be and the same is hereby fixed at FIFTEEN MILLION THREE HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY SIX DOLLARS (\$15,320,576) AND SAID SUM IS HEREBY ACCORDINGLY levied upon all property in said City subject to taxation aforesaid.

FIFTEEN MILLION THREE HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY SIX DOLLARS (\$15,320,576) being taxes to be levied for the fiscal year of this ordinance shall, when received, be used for the purpose of paying the following items for each of which an appropriation has been made in and by an Appropriation Ordinance passed by the Council of the City of Harvey; that the specific items as they appear in the Appropriation Ordinance are itemized hereinafter in the column headed "Appropriation" and the specific items and the amounts herein and hereby are listed in the column headed "From Tax Levy."
