

Public Safety *in Harvey IL*



Join Mayor Christopher J. Clark and city officials at City Hall on Saturday, February 4th at 11 a.m. for an important forum on public safety improvements in our city that have led to a **dramatic 55% drop in homicides from 2021.**

WHY THE DECREASE?

- The City purchased police body cameras, along with recent upgrades of police squad cars, non-lethal tasers, license plate readers and citation technology to support better policing in our city.
- We restructured the Harvey police department, putting more officers on the streets and added academy training to recruit more officers and attracted experienced officers from other area departments.
- We passed legislation that ceased liquor sales at midnight in Harvey which has led to a decrease in traffic after midnight, reduced activity on the city streets and the influx of non-Harvey residents to attend bars, clubs and other venues that offer liquor sales.
- We have fast-tracked block improvements like the demolition of abandoned buildings and the installation of speedbumps to slow out-of-control traffic in our neighborhoods.



Building a Better Harvey means building a safer Harvey, and through the initiatives Mayor Christopher J. Clark and the Harvey Police Department have taken, Harvey residents are safer today.
